Passes will be distributed to all eligible students during 1st period on the morning of parking lottery drawing. Only junior students who have a legal driver's license, which must be valid as of September 24th, appropriate insurance, and no severe disciplinary issues will be eligible for a parking permit. Since there are only 40 permits available, not all students who apply will be guaranteed a permit, as they will be issued based on a lottery drawing of all eligible applications.
