

This information generally appears on the title page of your book, with the usual exception of the copyright year (normally located on the reverse side of the title page).

This is the correct format for the **front section**--from the article's first page to the Criticism portion--of *Novels* (or *Short Stories*, *Poems*, *Nonfiction* or *Epics*) for Students.
