Use the most recent copyright year given.

book title, *italicized* (with any subtitle after a colon)  
(This should be underlined when hand-written.)

**Random, 2010.**

According to MLA (8<sup>th</sup> edition), write publishers' names in full with the following exceptions:

--Omit business words and abbreviations, like **Company** (*Co.*), **Corporation** (*Corp.*), **Incorporated** (*Inc.*), **Limited** (*Ltd*), etc.

Exs. Basic Books Corp.....Basic Books  
Houghton Mifflin Company.....Houghton Mifflin

--The words "University" and "Press" for an academic publisher should appear as abbreviations:

Exs. University of Chicago Press.....U of Chicago P  
University Press of Mississippi.....UP of Mississippi
