

**Emmaus High School 2020-2021 School Year
Information for LCTI Students
Updated September 9, 2020**

Dear Emmaus High School LCTI Families,

Thank you for your patience as we have worked with our partners at LCTI to ensure that our students continue to receive high-quality career and technical education, with appropriate modifications due to the current circumstances. LCTI students participating in the hybrid model with in-person instruction will follow the chart below:

Students will NOT attend LCTI on Wednesdays. Instead, students are expected to adhere to the remote learning guidelines set forth by LCTI. If you have children in the home with different last names, and have made arrangements for your child to attend school on a day that is not consistent with their last name, those arrangements will also be honored at LCTI.

Below is detailed information about LCTI scheduling, advisory and transportation for Fall 2020. This information was reviewed with all hybrid LCTI students last week during their in-person meeting.

This Week - September 8th - September 11th

Students in the Academic Center and Career Academy Program

- Students arrive at Emmaus High School by 7:23 a.m. and report to their designated bus for departure to LCTI at 7:35 a.m. *or* may commute directly to LCTI and dismiss at **2:45 p.m.**
- Students will NOT attend LCTI on Wednesdays. Academic Center and Career Academy Program students will work from home on all Wednesdays and complete work assigned under the remote learning guidelines set forth by LCTI.

Half-Day AM and PM LCTI Students

- Students will NOT attend LCTI on Wednesdays. All coursework assigned by LCTI will be completed online.
- This week, all half-day AM and PM LCTI students who selected the hybrid instructional model are participating in their EHS academic courses online, and attending their classes at LCTI according to the chart below.
 - Students with last names A-K went to LCTI on Tuesday, September 8th. On Wednesday, September 9th, all students were not required to attend, but were required to complete all coursework online.

- Students with last names L-Z will go to LCTI on Thursday, September 10th and Friday, September 11th.

Students in the Academic Center and Career Academy Program

- Students may arrive at Emmaus High School by 7:23 a.m. and report to their designated bus for departure to LCTI at 7:35 a.m. *or* may commute directly to LCTI and dismiss at **2:45 p.m.** Students utilizing district transportation will return to EHS on a bus. Transportation home will also be provided to those who ride a bus to school.
- Students will NOT attend LCTI on Wednesdays. Academic Center and Career Academy Program students will work from home on all Wednesdays and complete work assigned under the remote learning guidelines set forth by LCTI.

Half-Day AM and PM LCTI Students

- Students will NOT attend LCTI on Wednesdays. All coursework assigned by LCTI will be completed online.
- ***AM LCTI Students***
 - *Students who opted in to district transportation on the summer family survey* may take district transportation, walk, or be dropped off at Emmaus High School by 7:23 a.m. and report to their designated bus for departure to LCTI at 7:35 a.m. *or* may commute directly to LCTI.
 - The morning session will conclude at 10:35 a.m. daily. Students will be dismissed from LCTI and depart to Emmaus High School by 10:40 a.m. Students will arrive at Emmaus High School by 11:10 a.m during which time, Block 3 will be in session. Students will then return home and complete their EHS coursework remotely (online). Lunch is available on our campus for those students who wish to eat prior to returning home.
- ***PM LCTI Students***
 - Students will participate in their Emmaus High School classes remotely (online) during Block 1 and Block 2. Their morning classes will conclude at 9:33 a.m.
 - *Students who opted in to district transportation on the summer family survey* will take district transportation, walk, or be dropped off at EHS between 10:40 a.m. and 11:00 a.m. They should report to the main gym where bagged lunches will be available for students who elect to eat on campus before boarding their bus to LCTI. Students will arrive at LCTI between 11:30 a.m. and 11:40 a.m.
 - Students may also transport themselves directly to and from LCTI.
 - In order for students to obtain the required number of hours in their respective labs at LCTI, the afternoon session will conclude at **2:45 p.m.**, at which time students will be dismissed from LCTI. Students utilizing district transportation will return to EHS on a bus. Transportation home will also be provided to those who ride a bus to school.

Advisory

- All half-day LCTI students have been scheduled for a daily advisory period. This is a time for them to receive announcements, school updates, and participate in periodic lessons provided by our counseling or grade level offices. They will log into this advisory remotely through Schoology.
- PM LCTI students will participate in advisory at 9:43 a.m. AM LCTI students will begin advisory at 11:33 a.m. If your student is in transit to or from LCTI during this time and is unable to attend

on one or more of their in-person LCTI days, please have them contact their advisory teacher, who will excuse their absence and provide them with the information to access at a later time.

Transportation

- Students will have three options to choose from in order to attend their classes and programs at LCTI and Emmaus High School.
 - Students who opted in to district transportation on the summer family survey may utilize transportation provided by the district, which will be offered at the designated times for All-Day and Half-Day LCTI students.
 - Parents may transport their child in the mornings and/or pick them up at dismissal:
 - EHS - A.M. Drop-off is at the Auditorium Lot / P.M. Pick-Up is at Lot C (Door #4)
 - LCTI - Student drop-off and pick-up is at Lot #4.
 - Students with a valid driver's license may commute to LCTI and park on their campus. In order to park in the designated students parking lots at LCTI, students will need to obtain a parking permit from Mr. Will, Career and Technical Education Supervisor at LCTI. Mr. Will may also be contacted at wills@lcti.org with questions related to parking at LCTI.

Emmaus High School is planning to return to hybrid, in-person instruction on October 26th. In late October, we will send out information about logistics for LCTI students that go into effect on that date.
