This information generally appears on the title page of your book, with the usual exception of the copyright year (normally located on the reverse side of the title page). Use the most recent copyright year given.

authors' names, in the order they are presented. The first reversed...the second in normal order.* (Use the names exactly as given; that is, use initials only if listed that way in the text.)

Marci, Peter L., and Donald Paul Bakersfeld.

book title, *italicized* (with any subtitle after a colon) (This should be <u>undelined</u> when hand-written.)

most recent book year of city of publication publisher publication

Detroit: Gale, 2010.

For more than 3 authors, list all of the names.

When citing a group author, spell out the full name of the organization (do not use abbreviations).

Write names in the same order that they appear in the source (not necessarily in alphabetical order).
