This information generally appears on the title page of your book, with the usual exception of the copyright year (normally located on the reverse side of the title page). Use the most recent copyright year given.

author's name, reversed

book title, *italicized* (with any subtitle after a colon) (This should be underlined when hand-written.)

Endler, Joyce P. The Library: Reasons to Love It.

most recent year of publication

city of publication

book publisher

New York: Random, 2010.

Write out the names of associations, corporations, and university presses.

Leave out business abbreviations such as *Publishers*, *Co.*, and *Inc.* However, do write out the term "Books" and "Press."

Omit "The" (e.g., *University of Texas Press* rather than *The University of Texas Press*).
