

Program Objectives

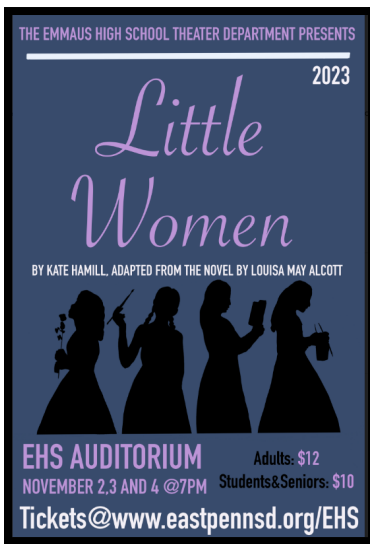
- Provide information on current youth drug trends, such as vaping, and the dangers of use to the developing brain and body

AP EXAM SIGN UPS:

The AP exam ordering period starts on Monday, October 2nd and runs through Friday, November 3rd. Students **must** order exams by using the [AP Test Registration Form](#). You must be registered for AP Classroom through CollegeBoard.org prior to ordering your exams through the registration form. If you are not yet registered in AP Classroom through CollegeBoard, please see your EHS AP teacher to assist you with getting registered.

The cost of each exam is \$98. Payment is by cash or check ONLY (payable to EHS). You do not need to write multiple checks if you are registering for more than one exam; a single check for the total amount is fine. If your family is experiencing financial hardship, such as qualifying for free/reduced lunch, please reach out to your Counselor or Mrs. Lucchesi-Wood.

All payments should be dropped off in Room 272 with Mrs. Lucchesi-Wood between 7:00am - 1:00pm daily. **All inquiries regarding the AP Exams should be directed to Mrs. Lucchesi-Wood in Room 272 or Mrs. Demchak in Counseling.**

NURSING UPDATES:

Just a reminder that if your student is feeling ill or has an injury in school they should report to the health room to be assessed by one of our nurses. If indicated, the nursing staff will contact the parent/guardian to discuss dismissing the student home during the school day. When sent home by the nurse, the student will receive an excused absence.

If a student calls a parent prior to coming to the nurses office and arranges for their parent to come and pick them up, the student will be sent to the main office. This will be a “parent excused” absence. Students will not be dismissed from the nurses’ office without being assessed by the nurse.

Also, just a reminder to keep sick students home. Do not send them to school if they have had a fever within the last 24 hours, are vomiting, are under a doctor’s care for a communicable illness, have tested positive for COVID-19, or have other symptoms that would interfere with the educational process.

If you have not done so already, please log into the SNAP portal and review your student’s health related information and provide any health updates your student may have to the school nurse.

If your student is staying home sick or has a doctor’s appointment and will be missing school, be sure to contact the attendance office to report the absence, not the SNAP portal. The SNAP portal is for updating medical information, doctor’s notes, and communication with the school nurses. The SNAP portal is not for submitting attendance related information.

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



INSCRIPCIONES PARA EL EXAMEN AP:

El período para solicitar el examen AP comienza el lunes 2 de octubre y finaliza el viernes 3 de noviembre. Los estudiantes **debe** ordenar exámenes usando el [Formulario de inscripción para el examen AP](#). Debes estar registrado en AP Classroom a través de [CollegeBoard.org](#) antes de ordenar sus exámenes a través del formulario de registro. Si aún no está registrado en AP Classroom a través de CollegeBoard, consulte a su maestro AP de EHS para que lo ayude a registrarse.

El costo de cada examen es de \$98. El pago se realiza ÚNICAMENTE en efectivo o cheque (a nombre de EHS). No es necesario que emita varios cheques si se registra para más de un examen; un solo cheque por el monto total está bien. Si su familia está experimentando dificultades financieras, como calificar para almuerzo gratis o precio reducido, comuníquese con su consejero o con la Sra. Lucchesi-Wood.

ACTUALIZACIONES DE ENFERMERÍA:

Solo un recordatorio de que si su estudiante se siente enfermo o tiene una lesión en la escuela, debe presentarse en la sala de salud para ser evaluado por una de nuestras enfermeras. Si está indicado, el personal de enfermería se comunicará con el padre/guardian para discutir la salida del estudiante a casa durante el día escolar. Cuando la enfermera lo envíe a casa, el estudiante recibirá una ausencia justificada.

Si un estudiante llama a sus padres antes de venir a la oficina de enfermería y hace arreglos para que sus padres vengán a recogerlo, el estudiante será enviado a la oficina principal. Esta será una ausencia "justificada por los padres". Los estudiantes no saldrán de la oficina de enfermería sin haber sido evaluados por la enfermera.

Además, solo un recordatorio para mantener en casa a los estudiantes enfermos. No los envíe a la escuela si han tenido fiebre en las últimas 24 horas, están vomitando, están bajo cuidado médico por una enfermedad transmisible, han dado positivo en la prueba de COVID-19 o tienen otros síntomas que podrían interferir con el proceso educativo.

Si aún no lo ha hecho, inicie sesión en el portal SNAP y revise la información relacionada con la salud de su estudiante y proporcione cualquier actualización de salud que su estudiante pueda tener a la enfermera de la escuela.

Si su estudiante se queda en casa enfermo o tiene una cita con el médico y faltará a la escuela, asegúrese de comunicarse con la oficina de asistencia para informar la ausencia, no con el portal SNAP. El portal SNAP sirve para actualizar información médica, notas del médico y comunicación con las enfermeras de la escuela. El portal SNAP no es para enviar información relacionada con la asistencia.
