



EHS Start-to-School Reminders

To Our EHS Students and Families,

As we settle into the new school year, we want to share a few important reminders to help keep Emmaus High School a safe, positive, and productive learning environment for everyone.

Appropriate School Attire

Please remember that clothing worn to school should be appropriate for the school environment. Clothing, tops and bottoms, should provide appropriate coverage and should not interfere with the learning environment. In addition, all words, images, graphics, and messages displayed on clothing must be appropriate for school.

We appreciate families taking a few moments to review these expectations with their students before they leave for school each morning.

Cell Phones & Wearable Technology

Students are not permitted to use or wear wearable technology during the school day, including smart watches and smart glasses. This includes smart glasses that also contain prescription lenses. Students who require prescription glasses should wear glasses without smart-technology capabilities while at school.

Additionally, during class time and homeroom, cell phones must be turned off and handed in/stored in the designated classroom location. These expectations are intended to reduce distractions and allow students to be fully engaged in learning.

FREE Breakfast Every Morning!

We also want to make sure every student knows that breakfast is FREE for all students every morning!

Students have two options:

- **Grab & Go Breakfast in the HIVE** — a quick option designed to help students get breakfast and still arrive at class on time.
- **Hot Breakfast in the Cafeteria** — also available every morning.

Both options are completely **FREE** for all students. We encourage students to take advantage of them!

Attendance & Arriving on Time

Finally, we cannot emphasize enough the importance of regular attendance. **We want and need our students at school every day.** Being present allows students to learn, build relationships with their teachers and classmates, participate in school activities, and receive the academic and personal supports available to them.

Please also remember that classes begins promptly at 7:23 a.m. Students should plan to arrive with enough time to enter the building and get to class before the bell.

Exterior doors close at 7:21 a.m. Students arriving after 7:21 a.m. must enter and sign in through the Main Office and will be marked tardy for the day. We encourage students to build a few extra minutes into their morning routines so they can begin their day on time and ready to learn.

Every day—and every minute—matters. If a student or family is experiencing challenges that are making regular or on-time attendance difficult, please reach out to us. We want to work with families and help remove barriers whenever possible.
