The student or staff member should not remove their mask at any time when in any room with another person (the day of exposure is considered Day 0).</p>				<p>Exposed household contacts isolate for 5 days, and then quarantine is an additional 5 days. This is a total of 10 days. If the exposed household member tests positive, the process for household contacts starts over. Please consult your school nurse to discuss your individual circumstances (the day of exposure is considered Day 0).</p>
