## Health and Safety Plan Summary and COVID Response Information

(As of 7/10/23)

\*This information is subject to change. Please continue to refer back to this document.

- If you test positive for Covid-19, please report to the nurse and it will be documented. All DOH reporting requirements will be followed. Students and Staff should stay home if they develop <u>Symptoms of COVID-19</u> or test positive and notify their school nurse. Parents and staff should continue to follow the notification process we have established with our nursing department, should a household member be diagnosed with COVID-19.
- 2. Masks are optional in school buildings and on school district vehicles. Masks are required in district health rooms if students/staff have <u>Symptoms of COVID-19</u>.
- 3. School classrooms and facilities will return to pre-pandemic layouts to prioritize in person instructional experiences. Practices may be utilized to increase physical distancing, as needed.
- 4. Students and staff will be required to wash hands or sanitize before lunch. Students and staff should have opportunities to wash hands throughout the day and will always have the option to wash hands when it is requested.
- 5. High touch areas (ie: door handles, sink handles, stair handle/rails, light switches, bottle filling stations, etc. - varies per bldg) will be sanitized often in accordance with facilities sanitization guidelines. Locker handles/areas will be sanitized at least once daily; and at the conclusion of each day. Classrooms will be cleaned and disinfected nightly.
- 6. Individuals exposed to COVID-19, regardless of vaccination status, who are not exhibiting any <u>Symptoms of COVID-19</u> will no longer be required to quarantine from school.
- Parents will be asked to screen students at home each morning as they did during the 2020/21 school year. Any students or staff who are experiencing <u>Symptoms of COVID-19</u> will be asked to stay home.
