FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS:

- 1. Can we bring food or drink?
 - a. You may not bring in any outside food and/or drinks
- 2. Is paying cash an option at the concession stands?
 - a. Concession stands are card only. You may only use cash at Chickie's and Pete's
- 3. Where is the ADA location?
 - a. ADA locations are first come first serve. They are located at the top of sections 110/111/112 and are also located at 105/106
- 4. Where is the closest parking? What is the cost?
 - a. The closest parking garage is the Linden Street Garage *OR* "Orange Garage" attached to PPL Center. It is located off of 7th and Linden. The cost for parking for graduations this year are \$3 if purchased off of Park Mobile and \$5 if purchased on the day of, entering the garage.
- 5. Do we provide listening devices for older guests?
 - a. We may provide listening devices for older guests, however this must be coordinated in advance with PPL Center so we can make sure we have the appropriate devices to accommodate.
- 6. Do we allow strollers into the graduation?
 - a. Strollers are allowed into all graduation ceremonies.
- 7. Do we have a place to hold the strollers while attending the graduation?
 - a. Strollers may be held at the Guest Services desk which is located at section 113, or any section at the top of the concourse that permits space to store a stroller.
- 8. Can attendees bring balloons, flowers, etc.?
 - a. Guests are not advised to bring balloons. Flowers are permitted. Please follow up with your school AND/OR PPL Center's website for more details on permitted/prohibited items.
- 9. Will someone be selling flowers/balloons at the venue?
 - a. This ultimately depends on the school. Please follow up with your graduating school for more details regarding flower/balloon arrangements. PPL Center will not be providing any flowers/balloons.
